10 tips to get you started...



Set a budget Plan ahead, consider your savings and any other investments you might have.



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Give your Employer 0 plenty of notice

Aim for at least three months, so you can enjoy your final days at work.



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Remind your employer to let LPPA know you're retiring

Request your lifetime allowance (LTA) figures

If you have any other pensions, already in payment, you'll need your LTA figures from each provider to complete your retirement form.



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Track down any old pension pots

You don't want to miss out on any benefits!

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Fill in your retirement forms sooner rather than later

We'll send you your forms in the post once your employer has confirmed you're going to retire (and your salary details).

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Double check your bank details



This must be a personal or joint account in your name.

Dig out your birth certificate
